much education as possible. In his Honor and Memory, the Evans Organization is proud to announce the Albert L. Evans, Sr. Scholarship Award Program.

- Four scholarships will be awarded to the most deserving candidates
- Each scholarship's maximum value will be \$5,000. (\$1,250 per year up to 4 years. The actual amount of the scholarship may vary depending on the number of years it takes the recipient to earn the degree.) The monies are paid directly to the school.
- · Scholarship winners will be eligible for an additional \$1,250 each year of their education, provided they meet certain requirements. (Specifically, parent(s) must still be employed by or leased onto one of the companies within the Evans organization; or an Agent or Employee of an Agent. The recipients must maintain a 3.0 GPA. Official transcripts from said institution must be submitted as proof of the required grade point average.)

The Albert Evans, Sr. Scholarship is now \$ 5.000!

Jordyn made a difference in this world and the Evans organization wants to ensure that her legacy lives on.

 The winner of the award will receive \$1,000 towards the purchase of his/her textbooks. Receipts for textbooks must be submitted, and the student will be reimbursed for the purchase, up to \$1,000.





Tom was a former employee and close member of the Evans family who was diagnosed with ALS, aka Lou Gehrigs disease. Tom was a wonderful human being. He was a kind, caring, gentle soul, generous with his time and his love. He always put other people first and himself second. Award is based on the recipient's attitude and actions in life as demonstrated through their personal essay, awards and activities.





SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Eligibility

Eligible applicants are children of an Evans Employee who is currently employed by Evans. Agents and Employees for an Agent are eligible. Children of Drivers and Independent Contractors are also eligible. Candidates must be seniors in high school or currently enrolled in an under graduate program and be in good academic standing at their school.

Application Process

- 1. Complete the official Scholarship Application found on page 3.
- 2. Complete the required essay.

Write a personal statement in which you tell the Scholarship Committee about yourself. Use the following questions as a guideline to assist you in writing your personal statement. You <u>must</u> incorporate <u>all</u> of the topics listed below. Statement must be typed, double-spaced and should not exceed (3) three pages.

- How have you impacted the world in a positive meaningful way?
- What actions have you taken that made your community, school, and family life better?
- What accomplishments are you most proud of and why?
- What are your career and/or educational goals?
- What significant factors or events in your life impacted your decision to attend college?
- Who has inspired you the most and how has that individual made a difference in your life?

3. Submit 2 Personal References.

In addition to the application and essay, please submit 2 references. One reference must be from a teacher. The second can be anyone of your choice, but not a family member.

4. Submit Official Transcript.

Please submit an official transcript from your high school and/or college.

5. Submit completed application, essay, references and transcript by January 31, 2020.

Completed applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee. Winners will be announced, April 2020.
